A father who went through the Mfld. sealing Disaster of 1914 & through exposure on the ice for about 50 hours is not very strong is writing for my son Harold G. Abbott who is in training with the regiment in St John's, I need Harold G. for the summer Months, I have a trap & Motor boat & as I am not strong, & Harold G. is the only one I had to depend upon, will you please send him home with me & until October & I am willing if he's needed for him to

come back with the regiment again.

I have a large family depending on me, six children at home with me now, the eldest boy is 16 years of age, he have had two attacks of pneumonia & cannot work hard, the only other help I have is a boy of 15 years who has asthma & cannot help with the fishery as a very little wet lay him up for days.

Now sir please pass this before the exemption committee & do send him home to help me for the summer, for to a certain extent he was my only help, my right arm.
