Dear Sir:-

This Department has written several letters to No. 1541 Pte. James Fredk. Allen, Curling, in an endeavour to secure from him information which is urgently needed by the Dept of the D.G.R & E., but to this date, no reply has been received.

Our letters advised him that notification had been received from the Imperial War Graves Commission, that a grave had been found 1,000 yards South West of Beaumont Hamel, France, which bore a wooden cross inscribed- No. 1541 Pte. J. F. Allen, 1st Nflds. Before 1/12/17. We requested if he could give the name and other details of any soldier who was likely to have been in possession of any of his property, and who may have been buried at the point named above, as the body of the soldier buried in the grave apparently carried some articles which bore the Allen's Regimental No. and name.

As this is a matter of great importance, I shall be very grateful if you will endeavour to interview or communicate with Pte. Allen - if he still resides in Curling- and obtain the statement asked for.

All Messages Sent are Subject to the Following Conditions:

The Management may decline to forward the Message, though it has been received for transmission; but in case of so doing shall refund to the Sender the amount paid for its transmission.
