Above noted man was before Demobilization Travelling Board on 29-11-18 and was recommended for the attention of the Standing Medical Board. Through an error he was demobilized and allowed to proceed to his home without appearing before them.

From the records in the Orderly Room it is learned he was reported sick at home 23-6-18 (according to his own statements) and returned to Depot for duty on 8-9-18. There is no Medical Certificate to support this, but it is likely this may be on file in Medical Department.

I would suggest that his case be placed before the M.O. Depot so that we may decide if it is necessary to recall him for examination.
