Reference reverse: The instructions regarding adjustment of this Soldier's account appears to have been misunderstood. It is now observed that pay was credited from 12/8/18 and balance of £8.18. 0 debited. It is noted that action was not taken in accordance with this office instructions 14298, 5/9/18, but £5.6.10 was credited and credit of pay from 12/8/18 allowed to stand. The amount of £5.6.10 should only have been credited if his account was dealt with in accordance with H.F.P/22 No. 217, 25/8/18, i.e., Pay credited from 2/7/18 and debit balance of £1. 6. 8 brought forward. A complete statement (No. 1) of the Soldier's account from 12/8/18 to the end of the last period is enclosed for reference and shows a balance due by the Soldier of £5.6.10. His account should be adjusted in Pay Books for current period shown on statement No. 2. The overcredit of £5.6.10 being debited under Col. 24 and observations on account for period ended 30/8/18 adjusted as shown.
