Dear Sir:-

Would you kindly let me know if there is any possible chance for me to draw the remaining three months pay of my gratuity when due, - without waiting for another eight or ten months, as the Militia Department now proposes doing - as I need the remainder very much to help pay my part of a home which we have recently purchased.

The reason the Militia Dept, or Capt Howley refused the third payment ~~on~~ August 18th when cheque was due, was because I had managed to get a little help from the Civil - Reestablishment Committee in connection with an Electrical Course that I am now getting at Reid's. This course which I am getting is to last eight or ten months and probably longer, so if I have to wait till it is finished it means that I shall have to wait till nearly the end of 1920 before I can get

all of my gratuity money, and I may say that
it is nearly seven months since arriving on this
side having arrived here by "Corsican" on 7th of 8th.

So I would like to know whether you
would make any arrangements whereby I could
draw future payments when due.

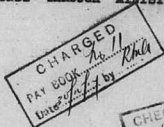


