

Rev. and dear Sir:

I am in receipt of your letter of April 30th, forwarding Cemetery Register Form for 1493 Ptc. Ernest Brown, which, incidentally, has not been completed. In connection with Headstones for soldiers buried in this country I would state that the Imperial War Graves Commission will be despatching a Headstone for every grave. In view of the fact that the parents of the soldier in question have already erected a stone it will be possible to forward the Standard Memorial to them to be erected locally, of, if they should prefer it, to erect the Standard Memorial over the soldier's grave and thereby having it marked as every soldier's grave on the battlefield is marked, and taking the stone already erected to Tacks Beach.

In answer to your second query I am afraid there is no possibility of a refund being made for the stone already erected. This matter has been taken up with the Imperial War Craves Commission and they are unable to consider refunds in this connection.

I am returning the Form herewith and would appre-

ciate it if you will have a suitable Inscription written in accordance with the instructions, and also have the Form signed.
