

Brown, and in reply I beg to inform you that he arrived in St. John's on Sunday March 23rd, and has since received his discharge from the Regiment at the Depot St. John's and has been issued a Railway Pass to proceed to his home, but I cannot say definitely whether he left St. John's or not, as when a man is discharged from the Regiment he is perfectly justified in going where he pleases, but I have no doubt that before this letter reaches you or perhaps a little later he will have arrived home.

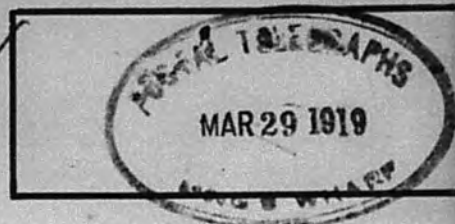

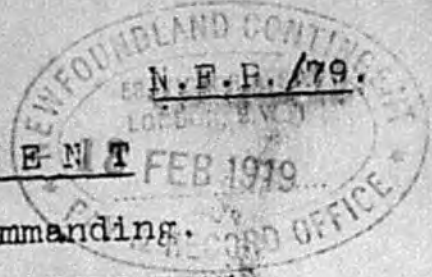
