It was with great regret that the Government received a cable from the Record Office. London, intimating that your son, Private Herry Brown, had been Killed in Action on the 12th instant,

On behalf of the Government, as well as for myself, I desire to express to you the sincerest sympathy in your time of sorrow. But though we feel the parting and though the heart is heavy with its loss, yet it is a glorious thing to think that your gallant boy early responded to the call of duty and made his stand for the establishment of Righteousness, Truth and Liberty upon the earth. We are all proud of our brave and noble boys but no less do we esteem the unselfish fathers and mothers who so willingly gave their boys when the call of duty came. Though your boy has laid down his earthly weapons he wears the soldier's Crown of Victory and his name is inscribed upon the glorious Roll of Honour and will be held in fragrant memory by all his fellow countrymen. When the end of this War comes and an honourable and abiding Peace will have been established, it will be your proud thought that your dear boy did to the utmost of his ability to bring about such result. I trust that the Great Father may give you of his love and comfort at this time.

The above-mentioned man were reported as buried in Menin Read Harth Military Cometery. This Cometery was severely shelled and the greater number of graves were chilterated. The remains of the Soldiers buried there have therefore been removed to Menin Read South Military Cometery. (Sheet 28, I.9.4.2.6) but when this work was carried out it was impossible to identify the graves of these men.

Their remains have been therefore been included on a Memorial Cross which has been erected in Menin Read South Military Constary and on which the following inscription appears—

"To the memory of these 54 British and Deminion Soldiers, Killed in Action 1915/1917 and burjed at the time in Memin Road Marth Military Cometory which was destroyed by the enemy".

> "Their Clery shall not be blotted out". Kindly inform the mext-of-kin.
