It was with extreme regret that the Government received today from the Record Office, London, a message stating that your son, Private James Michael Brown, had been killed in action on the 3rd December. Permit me to express, on behalf of the Government as well as for myself, the sincerest sympathy with you and your family at this time. Our hearts feel the pang of parting, and we sorrow at the loss of our loved ones. but it is no doubt come comfort to you that your son died with his face to the foe, fighting bravely for some of the most important and vital principles of our existence.

Your gellent lad came forward early at the call of
King and Country and fought nobly and courageously for
the establishment of Righteousness, Truth and Liberty upon
the earth. Though he has now laid down his earthly weapons,
he wears instead the soldier's crown of victory, and his name
will be inscribed upon the glorious Roll of Honour, and be
kept in fragrant memory by all his fellow countrymen. When
that Peace comes, for which we and our Allies are striving,
it will, I trust, help to cheer your hearts to think that
your noble boy had no small part in bringing about that
desired end. We are proud of our young men who have so
courageously done their part in this great crists, but we
are equally proud of the noble, unselfish mothers and fathers

who have so willingly given their boys to their King and the Empire's service.

I trust that, at this time, you and yours may have the sweet comfort of the Great Father of us all.
