Dear Mrs. Sweeney,

Sir Edward Morris has forwarded me your letter of April 11, which was directed to him at London, but which he did not receive until his arrival here. I much regret the delay which has occurred.

I shall forward your request to the proper quarter regarding furlough for your son, No. 2081, Private John Cahill.

But the rule is this: All men discharged from Hospital are marked according to their health. A & B classes are fit for light duty. C & D. classes are fit only for light duty or home defence.

If your son is classified in C or D, the Doctor may certify that he would benefit by a sea voyage or by a change home. If he is in A or B, furlough is not permitted. But parents and relatives have the satisfaction of knowing that the young soldier is in good health and strength.

You will well understand that it would not do for me or for anybody to override or

attempt



attempt to modify the wise decisions of the highest  
Military Authorities.

Dear Madam,

I am in receipt of your letter respecting your son, Private John Cahill, and asking if it were possible to grant him furlough. Permit me to say that this is a matter that is dealt with by the Military Authorities in the United Kingdom and it is for them to grant any such privilege. You will no doubt appreciate that we out here do not know the contingencies that exist in relation to men nor the demand made upon the Reserve in order to keep the Battalion up to full strength. We are, therefore, unable to say anything in relation to the granting of furlough or leave of absence, the control of which must be left in the hands of the Commanding Officer. No doubt, if your boy would make the request himself and it were found possible to grant it, the Commanding Officer would look favourably upon the same.
