



**Carter, Charles F. Regt. No. 1403**

**Distinguished Conduct Medal**

*London Gazette, December 2nd, 1919.*

*Action Date, October 3rd, 1918 – Ledeghem.*

For conspicuous gallantry and devotion to duty on October 3rd, 1918 at Ledeghem. The enemy put down a heavy barrage prior to counterattacking and under cover of a timber yard pushed forward a machine gun and were causing several casualties. Cpl. Carter with a section worked his way forward among the timber, opened fire on the enemy and silenced the gun. He established a post well out in the timber yard and remained there during the remainder of the counterattack.
