I am directed to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of August 8th., concerning your son #3557 L/C. John Cater, with reference to his promotion, I would point out that promotion of Non-commissioned Officer is a matter entirely in the hands of his Commanding Officer, and is not referred in any instance to this Department.

It is pleasing to note that he has passed his course of instructions, and it will be only a matter of time when he should be promoted as he is apparently keen on getting ahead. I am sure that he will make every effort himself to further his own interest.

I am afraid it will not be possible to obtain furlough for him at present, the matter of furlough is governed of course by the War Office, and except in special cases furlough is not granted, and the only repatriation allowed are men being sent home for discharge.



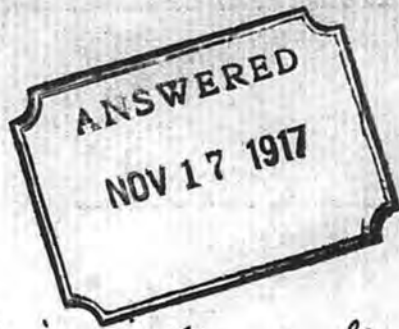
