Cable Connection with all the World

All Messages Sent are Subject to the Following Conditions:

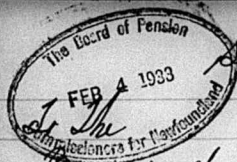

This will acknowledge your letter of recent date with reference to the balance of allotment which you claim you are entitled to receive subsequent to your son's death.

According to your statement the last amount you received was in May 1918, whereas your son was killed in action on December 3rd., 1917. Ordinarily this allotment should have ceased at the time of his death but was continued for the purpose of giving the Pensions' Board time to consider dependency in the matter of pension, and this did not mean that it would be continued for any definite period.
