1. Letter 139, 2/12/16 from H.E. Governor to Paymaster:


"I have the honour to annex a letter received from the Rev. W.H. Thomas of St. John's under date 29th ultimo on behalf of No. 78 C.S.M. Wilbur Chancey, in which he asks that Chancey may be considered a candidate for a Commission.

Kindly forward this letter to the Officer Commanding the Battr. to which C.S.M. W.Chancey is posted with the request that the application may be considered according to Military Rule."

2. Letter from Rev. W.H.Thomas, Congregational Parsonage, St. John's to H.E. Governor, 29/11/16:

"Will you kindly permit me to draw your attention to the case of a member of my congregation who enlisted early and left here with the first contingent. His name and No. are 78 Wilbur Chancey. He was a member of the Highlanders Brigade here, and an officer in it. When he left for England he was, I believe, a Sergeant. He has been since Company Q.M. and Regimental Q.M. (temporarily). His permanent rank today is I believe Sergeant-Major, though he has at times acted in higher capacity. He is a very sensitive man and would not push himself forward to secure a commission; but I believe he would welcome an opening and he should be

No 78 C.Q.M.S. Chancey was acting R.S.M. for some considerable period and was given every opportunity to improve his efficiency by being sent to the South Army School. The Commanding Officer did not consider him efficient for the rank and he was put back to his permanent rank. The utmost care & trouble is taken in the selection of men for commissions and it is extremely unlikely that any man with G.M.S. Chancey's rank would be overlooked.




