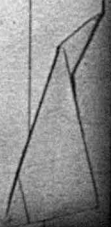

For your Excellency's information re#238 Pte John Hynes, This man was a private in A Company of the first five hundred, and when we were at Stobbss Camp he got permission to get married to a woman residing in Edinburgh. I think this would account for his wishing to take his discharge at Ayr, Scotland. He was a well-conducted man in the Regiment, and came with us to Gallipoli where he became medically unfit.

RE 3284 PTE.C.HOWELL. This is the man whom your Excellency advised should be discharged on account of his eyes. He was boarded last night and recommended for discharge.

RE 3376 PTE.W.CHAULK. This man was sent back from Winsor by Major Montgomerie, and was boarded and recommended for discharge.




