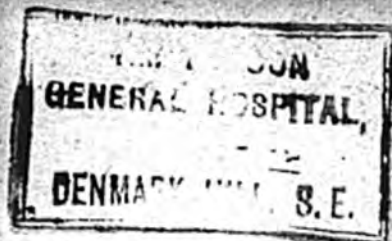



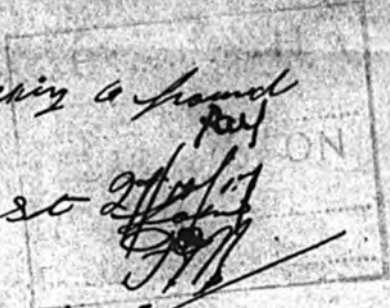

Otherwise it is a case to be discouraged, and it is hoped that it will be possible to do so.

No. 1502, G. Clarke, was sent some money by his Father from St. John's, Nfld. and as he did not receive it he wrote the Pay Office.
