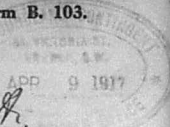

Descriptive Return of a Soldier Discharged on Account of Disability

Dear Sir Patrick,

The bearer, 1933 Pte. S. Clarke, informs me that he was discharged and pensioned in May 1917: his pension being assessed at \$8 per month. Since then he made one trip, last summer, in a fishing schooner and was occupied for one month, but he had to give up this employment as he was not able to perform the work. He subsequently secured employment with Mr. S.E. Garland, Stationer in this city, and worked there for one month and a half, when he had to give up this employment also owing to his physical condition.

He informs me that his present condition of health renders him absolutely unable to work and the amount of his pension is not sufficient to keep himself and his wife from starvation.

I commend this man's case to your immediate consideration as, from appearances, he is in poor shape and something further should be done for him if he is in the condition which he represents himself to be. I presume the proper course would be to have him again boarded to ascertain his present disability.
