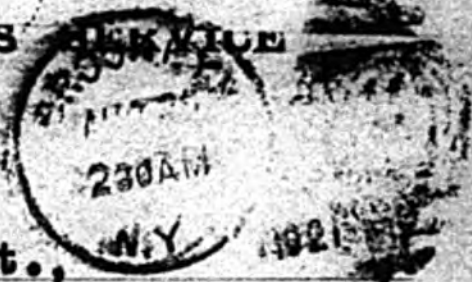

Dear Sir:-

Confirming our telephone conversation of yesterday, I have to report to you that William R. Cleary, late King's Corporal, 1st Newfoundland Regiment, discharged from the Service March 8th., 1918, left Boston on Friday evening, September 27th., for New York.

Previous to his departure, Mr. Cleary had been into my office asking for transportation to Newfoundland via New York. I told him that we could not send him until we received word from Newfoundland as to what they wanted done with him, and that we could not send him to New York till we heard from the Red Cross there as to whether his family was willing and able to take care of him.

Mr. Cleary said that there was a boat leaving New York Saturday and he could not wait; that he was going to take a chance on beating his way to New York.

I advised him against this and told him to return Saturday morning at 11 o'clock when I expected to have a telegram from New York. Mr. Cleary did not return although the telegram came saying that if you would send him to New York his family would send him to Newfoundland.

So far as I can see, we shall have to let the matter rest there as the man has left our care against our advice.
