



Our first Informant, L/Cpl. Alfred N. Brown 1987, 1st Newfoundland Regt., B Coy., VII Platoon, now in the 2nd London General Hospital, King's Road, Chelsea, and whose home address is 26 Belvedere Street, St. John's Newfoundland, states:-

"I knew Lt. S.B. Cole. He was my platoon officer that day, and I know that he was very badly wounded. The Germans counter-attacked and we were pushed back, and Lt. Cole was left behind in the trench. A patrol of our men went out to search for him that night but could not find him. The Hampshires got back over the ground the next day."

Our second information is from Sgt. Major A.E. Taylor 1554, 1st Newfoundland, now in Camp in France, he says:-

"I saw Lt. Cole wounded by a bomb explosion, just as we reached our objective at Brounbeke. I was quite close to him at the time. He had to be left there. He must have died." 8028



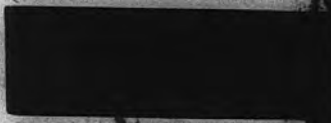


