Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 16th instant, and hasten to express my regret that any unnecessary suffering should have been caused by the manner in which notifications respecting Missing Men have been communicated from this Department.

I would say that in reporting deaths, our invariable practice is to communicate the sad intelligence through the Clergyman of the particular denomination concerned, and care is taken that the official intimation is not sent from the office to the next of kin until we are assured that the clergyman has broken the news. In the case of Missing Men, however, as the intelligence does not necessarily convey the news of a death, it has been considered sufficient to communicate direct with the next of kin. If, after the lapse of several months, no further tidings are received, the official War Office notification is received by us that the man is now believed to have been Killed in Action, and, as it is presumed, owing to the lapse of time, the friends of the deceased man have given up hope, such notification is also sent direct and not through the clergyman.

I may say that yours is the first complaint of the kind which has reached me, and I regret that the mother of the man reported should have been distressed by the manner in which the news was conveyed. I have,

Dear Sir,

Will you kindly, when acquainting relatives of those "missing" or killed in battle, do so, if they are or were Catholics, through the parish priest - at least in Parch Cove and Flatrock. It is a very hard thing for a delicate mother (as happened this week in Parch Cove) to hear abruptly in a cold, formal way that her child is slain or missing. It is not my business what manner is employed in breaking the news to others not of my faith; but it is my business where those of my fold are concerned. It was most distressing last Monday to witness one poor mother's grief as alone and well she was told of her son being missing. Will you kindly inform me in future if any such sad case should happen? The name should indicate (and does in

this case) the young man's religion.
