Your letter of the 25th. inst. addressed to Lieut.Col. W.F. Rendell has been passed to me for attention and reply.

With regard to the enclosed B.P. for Private monument erected by Mr. Chas. Gull in memory of his son the late Private Frank Gull, it is regretted that this Department has no funds available to meet expenses for private monuments.

This Department, in the treatment of War Graves, is governed by the Regulations issued by the Imperial War Graves Commission which defines a War Grave as "Deaths caused or aggravated by War Service occurring between the 4th. of August, 1914, and the 31st. August, 1921, will constitute a War Grave".

As the veteran in question, Frank S. Gull, died about a year ago it is regretted that under existing regulations his grave cannot be treated as a War Grave.
