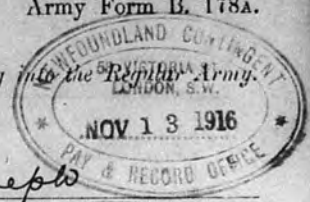

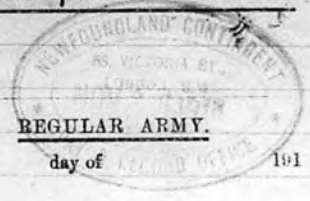

NOTES.—(i.) 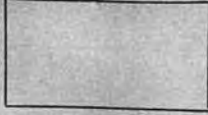
