I have the honour to enclose copies of two cables I received from Mayson M. Beeton, Esq., London, dated March the fourth and fifth. With reference to Sergeant Dean, he is rather an old man and has done exceptionally good work, he is a native of Botwood. As to his being dissatisfied or not, I don't suppose that counts for much, as when one enlists, discipline has to be carried. However, Dean is a ~~good~~ very good man indeed, and as Thistle is coming back for discharge, I presume there will be room for Lieutenantancy.
