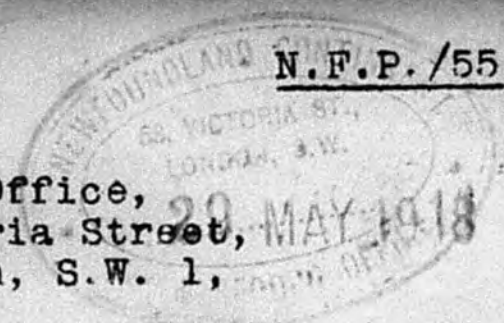



I should like to bring the matter of the above named N.C.O.'s position to your notice.

He arrived in St. John's on leave with the Blue Puttee Draft last August and his rank on all the Nominal Rolls was a/R.Q.M.S. When the Blue Puttee leave was at an end, he was attached ~~acting~~ for duty at the Depot in the Demobilization Office where he has been at work ever since.

No intimation was ever received at the Depot that he reverted to the rank of Staff-Sergeant, and he has been wearing the badges of the rank of a/R.Q.M.S. and drawing pay accordingly ever since.

His statement of account for the month of January has just been received and shows a Debit balance of \$35.40. On the form appears the statement that he "reverts to S/Sgt. 23-7-18" which is the first notification of the reversion. Meanwhile, he has an allotment of 60¢ per day and has been drawing up to the full extent of his pay, so that the loss of the 20¢ per day for 6 months back places him in debt to that amount.
