Your Excellency:

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your letter of September, 27th., having reference to an application for furlough for #357 Cpl. R. Flemming.

On receipt of your letter I made enquires concerning his case, and why he was not allowed to proceed to Newfoundland on "Blue Puttee" leave.

It appears that on the 5th., of August when he was a Corporal he was tried by Field General Court-Martial on three charges, (1) drunkenness (2) striking the soldier (3) conduct to the prejudice of good order and military discipline. He was found "not guilty" of the first and second charges, but "guilty" of the third charge, and was sentenced to be reduced to the ranks.

Your Excellency will understand that it would not be advisable in view of the foregoing circumstances, to apply for furlough for this soldier.

Perhaps, at some later date when furlough is applied for for a larger number of men, his case might be considered.
