I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of 1st inst., and attached letter from Mr. Wm. Foley contents of which have been noted; and in reply thereto, I beg to state that M. Foley's son, No. 4156. Private Patrick Foley, enlisted in The Royal Newfoundland Regiment on Nov. 22nd, 1917, and gave his age as 19 years, and therefore it was not considered necessary to have the consent of his father, by the Military authorities, before sending him overseas.

As to compensation, which Mr. Foley thinks is due him, it is left entirely to Private Foley's own discretion, as to whether he thinks it advisable to make an allotment to his father or not.

Private Foley is now with the unit in France, and if Mb. Foley wishes, we will have instructions forwarded to him to communicate with his father.
