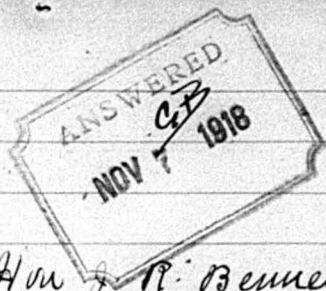
Dear Mr. Fowlow,
