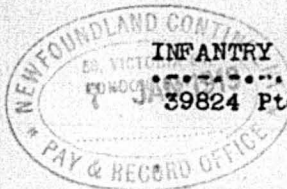

In answer to our inquiry as to the whereabouts of your son, #5279 Wm. Prizello, and as to the reason why he had not written home for twelve months, we are now in receipt of a reply. Pte. Prizello, who is in France with the 1st Battalion, was interviewed by his Company Commander and upon being questioned with regard to his neglect in writing home, stated that the reason was, that as he wrote you in October 1917, and received no reply to his letter, he did not think it of any use to write again. However, he promised to write on the night of April 24th to both you and his sister, and no doubt you will hear from him in the near future, if you have not already done so.



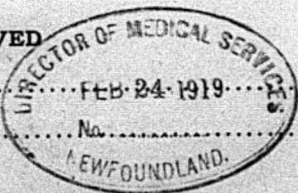
