Sir:

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of even date, requesting that arrangements be made for passage to England of:-

- (a) #144 G.S.M. Gardner, The Royal Newfoundland Regiment, who enlisted in October 1914 - and
- (b) Thomas Cockerham, Royal Naval Reserve, who enlisted on H.M.S. "Briton" January 1915, having been previously rejected for the Regiment.

The foregoing, and some previous applications, have raised the question as to whether it is to be the adopted policy of the Government to grant Men of the Royal Newfoundland Regiment, and Royal Naval Reserve, who have been repatriated to Newfoundland for demobilization, or otherwise, a return passage to Great Britain if they so desire it - it being understood that they belong to, or are domiciled there. This also raised the question as to men who are residents of Canada or the United States, who have been discharged here, applying for transportation to their home in either of these countries.

Up to the present, with one or two exceptions, these applications have been refused by this Department, but if the Government think it wise to grant this request, I would ask that a Minute of Council be passed putting same into effect which will obviate the necessity of having each case separately considered.

Gardner's and Cockerham's passage will be arranged as requested, but those of their wives and children will have to be at their own expense.
