OPINION OF THE MEDICAL BOARD.

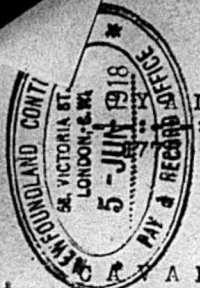

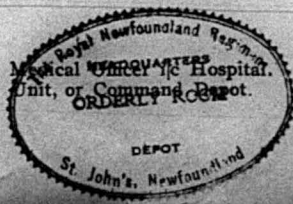

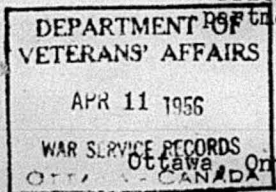
