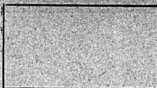

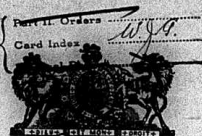

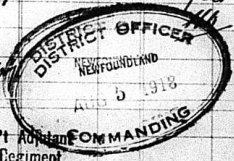

Dear Madam/-

A bill for \$26.00 contracted by 5608 ex-Pte. H.A.Gillingham has been passed me for certification on Regimental account. I am not aware of any authority being issued this man to incur a debt of this sum chargeable to Depot funds. When permission was given Gillingham to live out of Barracks, pending the disposal of his case, he was given the option of choosing his own Billet, where he would be given the usual Billeting allowance, viz. Ninety (90) cents per day. Any amount per day over that sum is at his own expense.
