With further reference to your communication of September 3rd and my reply thereto of September 6th, concerning the above noted soldier. I have had Pte. Hannefant paraded before me with a view to obtaining information concerning the circumstances. His father is alive and supports himself principally by fishing with the help of another son, John, aged 14. Private Patrick Hannefant was adopted by his uncle when 3 years of age and since he has enlisted in the Regiment he has been leaving an allotment of 60 cents per diem to the uncle.

Pte. Hannefant states that he does not wish to be released from the service and, as his enlistment has been carried out in the regular manner, the question of exemption is rather difficult as the man himself does not wish it.

The above named soldier came to see me this morning to explain his circumstances. He was one of the number rounded up by Sergt. Joy in Twillingate District in August last. At that time he had not reported for Service or applied for exemption in any way.

He was 19 years of age in April and enlisted in the Regiment August 17th.

He was given a letter from the Magistrate to Hon. J.A.Clift, K.C. and I received a letter from Messrs. Clift & Pinsent stating the man's circumstances and asking if an application for exemption might be considered. On enquiry from Private Hennafant, at the time, he stated that he did not wish to be released from the Service. His circumstances are as follows;

He has a father and one small brother living but Private Hennafant has been living with an uncle since he was 3 years of age, and has been the uncle's only support since he was old enough to work. He states that the Uncle is now left at home absolutely alone with no one to look after him as his father and his uncle have nothing to do with each other as his father is away most of the time.

Private Hennafant has been to see Messrs Clift & Pinsent again and wishes his case to be considered as he finds the uncle is in very poor circumstances at present.

Can anything be done in this case, please?
