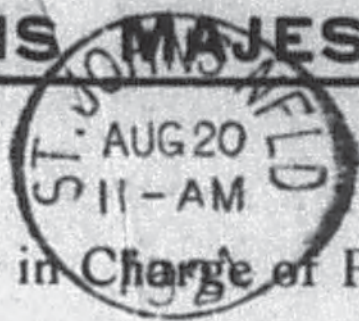



Mr. Reeves notified me at the time saying when he was ready to leave hospital would let me know.

But have not heard anything of his whereabouts since. Some of the boys

at the time said he was drafted on France again.

Surely that cannot be possible he wounded so badly.

Several boys that have returned home said he would be sent home, never fit for the front again. And then to hear he was gone to France.

You would do me a great favour if you would kindly let me know his whereabouts as you can guess how anxious a mother would be.

Sent several parcels & letters & books & papers but no letters in return. Anxious moments are spent in waiting to hear.

Kindly let me know if possible.

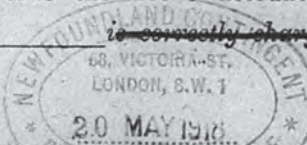

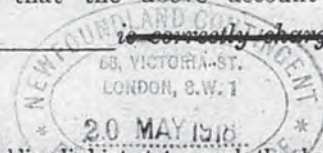
