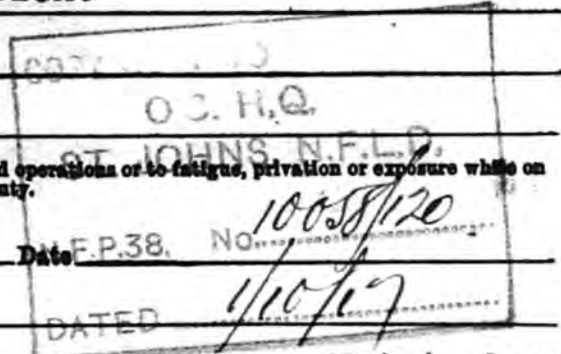

In reply to your letter of March 29th concerning the stoppage of allotment which had been paid on account of your son, #2679 Pte. Frank Kelly, I would state for your information that in accordance with the authority of the Government this allotment was continued for two years after date of death. In accordance with practice the case was then considered by the Board of Pension Commissioners who requested us to stop further payments. I may say that when allotments are continued after date of death, as in your case, the payments so made are on account of any pension that might be due and not as allotments. Payments are made at the request of the Pension Board who refund to this Department the amount expended, and it is at their request that payments through this Department cease.
