With reference to the communication of Squires & Winter dated September 6th. 1917. regarding claim of Micholas Kennedy of 11 Pleasant Street, father of Michael Francis Kennedy, who was killed in action on July 1st.1916, I beg to report that I have already had this man's case before the Pensions & Disabilities Board, but no action was taken at the present time, to give Ir. Kennedy an poportunity to prove conclusively to the satisfaction of the Board that he can be considered a dependent upon his late son.

This soldier, 'ichael Francis Kennedy formerly had an allotment payable to the mank of Nova Scotia, and the amount payable under this allotment would be placed to his own credit only. The allotment was cancelled sometime prior to his decease.

As the son did not make an allotment to the father or one of the family, while he was alive, it would naturally be understood that he did not consider his father to be dependent upon him. If, as the father states, the son was in the habit of sending him money from time to time, he should produce definite evidence to this effect, but until such time, as he can do so, his case cannot be favourably considered by the Pensions & Disabilities Board.



It was with the greatest regret that the Government received a cablegram from the Record Office, London, intimating that your son, Private Michael F. Kennedy, had been Killed in Action on the lat July.

Permit me to express on behalf of the Government, as well as for myself, the sincerest sympathy with you at this time. While we all sorrow at the loss of loved ones, yet it will no doubt be some consolation to you to think that your boy loyally answered the Call of King and Country, fought bravely and well and fell with his face to the fee in defence of the principles of Righteousness, Truth and Liberty. He has laid down the earthly weapons of warfare and now wears the Soldier's Crown of Victory. His name will be emblazoned upon the glorious Roll of Honour and be held in fragrant memory by all his fellow-countrymen. We are proud of our gallant lads and also of the noble fathers and mothers who so unselfishly gave their boys when the Call of Duty came. When the Victory has been won and Peace again reigns it will be a comfort to you to think that, in this great achievement, your gallant lad bore no small part, and gave of himself even to the uttermost.

. I trust that you may have at this time the presence and consolation of the Great Father of us all.
