**Military Cross**

*London Gazette, 11th December 1916*

*Action Date, 12th October 1916*

For conspicuous gallantry in action. He showed marked courage and skill in organizing the defence of the position. He himself accounted for three of the enemy. He set a splendid example to his men.

**Croix de Guerre (French)**

*London Gazette, May 1st 1917*

*Action Date, October 12, 1916 – Gueudecourt*

He showed the greatest determination as senior officer in hostile captured trench, organizing the defence and beating off a counter attack. He himself bayoneted 3 Germans. It was largely due to his own personal example and coolness that the trench was held.
