In reply to your letter of the 10th instant, I beg to explain that the reason why the notification respecting No. 2877, Private Norman Martin, was not addressed to you is that in the attestation papers given at the time of Private Martin's enlistment, the name of his father, Mr. Eliot Martin, was given as his next of kin. I presume that his marriage took place subsequent to the date of enlistment, and as we had received no information to that effect, our records up to the present time have shown the next of kin as above. 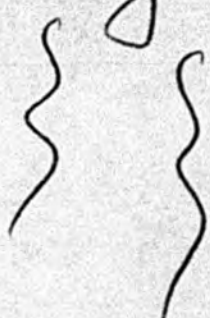

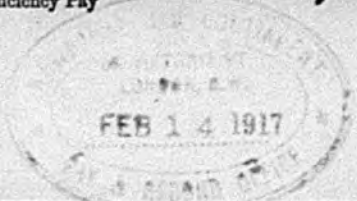
