While advancing on July 1st 1916 at the battle of the Domme he was wounded in the left shoulder: he knelt down to remove his equipment when he was wounded a second time - in the left side and spine. He was removed to hospital & for some time was paralyzed in the legs. This paralysis quickly passed away and he recovered the use of his legs completely. He is unable to stoop on account of the spine injury & he cannot walk far or comfortably for the same reason. The wound over the spine is still discharging & occasionally pieces of bone are removed from it.

There is a circular scar 1" diameter just below the tip of the coracoid process on the left side there is another similar though larger scar at the top of the post. fold of left axilla both

these scars are soundly healed & the shoulder joint has good movement. In the region of the left hip there is (1) an oval, somewhat depressed scar over the crest of the ilium about the middle (2) an irregular discharging abs. scar over the lower lumbar & upper sacral region: this scar is firmly adherent to the underlying bone & there is a small discharging sinus near the centre of it; there has been loss of bone in this region & there is a marked projection of the lower lumbar vertebrae which are ankylosed. (3) a small horizontal scar over rt. iliac crest (piece of metal was removed from here) (4) a larger scar a little below the last mentioned (this resulted from wound received at Gallipoli). Patient walks with difficulty & keeps spine fixed: he cannot stoop. has to wear a poroplastic jacket.



This case is still under consideration of the Medical Board who will examine the X-Ray Photos of his Spine at next Meeting (this evening). There is no thought at present of further operation. He is recommended for Discharge, there being no chance of his again becoming fit for General Service.

The question of his being allowed to proceed Overseas should, in my opinion, not be considered. Even if he were in England I doubt if he would be granted permission to proceed from one part to another in search of a particular Medical Officer who is, of course, subject to orders to change his command at any moment.

To allow a discharged soldier (as he will be in a few days) to proceed Overseas for treatment would establish a precedent which, in my opinion, had best be avoided.

If the case of a soldier should prove one which our local surgeons cannot undertake then it would be for the Pensions & Disabilities Board to make arrangements with the Canadian M.H.C.C. for his case.

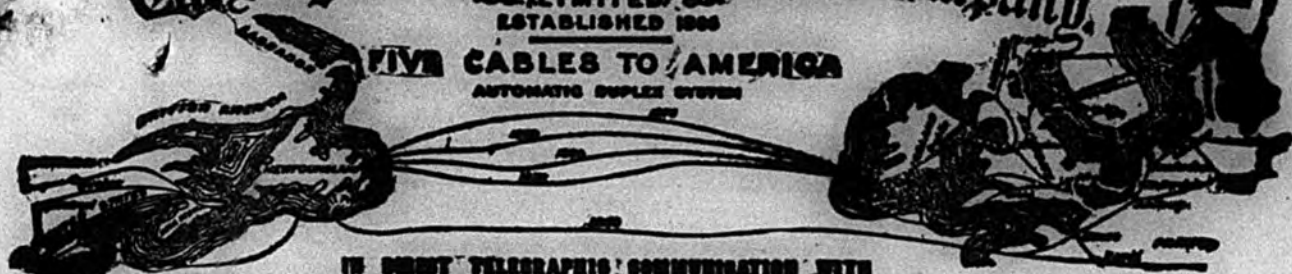
