With reference to the attached claim from the above named men for Board money due them to dates mentioned.

These men came home on Blue Puttee Leave at the expiration of which they reported to the Depot on or about October 4th/1918. They were required to report each morning at 9.30 when they were dismissed for the day. Later on those who wished to were granted a Conditional release for the purpose of taking up civilian employment. The numbers who did not seek this opportunity dwindled down gradually to about 10 men.

At the beginning of January I warned those who were reporting daily (and these included the above mentioned men) that they must either come into Barracks or lose their Subsistence Allowance. Of the men on Parade there was no one who wished to come into Barracks and so their names were struck off the Billeting List.

Neither Pte. Moore nor Pte. Murphy consequently is entitled to Board money after the 17th January.

"Under the provisions of the War Measures Act 1914-16  
it is ordered that any person who is or has been a member of  
His Majesty's Forces during the present War and who has  
suffered from any venereal disease, and who may still be  
suffering from the effects of said disease may, on the certi-  
ficate of the Medical or Acting Medical Health Officer setting  
forth the nature of the disease and recommending aggregation  
be arrested by any Peace Officer and placed in the Military  
Hospital at St. John's and there detained until pronounced  
cured by a certificate of the Medical or Acting Medical Health  
Officer, or the Medical Superintendent or the physician in charge  
of said Hospital.

Any person so detained who escapes from the said Hospital,  
or who refuses to comply with the rules and regulations of said  
Hospital, shall be guilty of a breach of this Order and liable  
on summary conviction to a fine of One thousand Dollars and in  
default of payment to one year's imprisonment."


