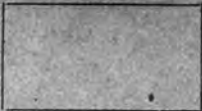
With reference to your letter of May, 7th., to the Minister of Militia I beg to state, that instructions were issued, to continue allotments on account of deceased men where such were payable to parents or other relatives who may possibly be claimants for Pensions.

The idea was, that the Pensions Board was not in a position to deal with these cases and could not begin to discriminate as to who should or who should not receive an allowance on account of Pension.

Consequently, this course was considered to be the most feasible, although it was recognized that payments of allotments would, under this ruling be continued in some cases, at least where no Pension would be sought or granted. The allotments so made are to be continued until cases concerned are finally disposed of by the Permanent Pensions Board, which hopes to commence operations very shortly.
