Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of Aug. 14th, concerning #520, L/Cpl. Wm. T. Newell. It is very much regretted that the request of this soldier's mother that he should be allowed to remain on duty in Newfoundland cannot be acceded to. When the Minister of Militia succeeded in obtaining furlough for the blue puttee men in France he gave his personal assurance to Sir Douglas Haig, Commander in Chief, that every man would be returned to duty in France at the end of the period allowed for furlough. It was because of these assurances that furlough was approved and not only for that reason but also because furlough for other men of our Regiment might be obtained. It is imperative that all the men who left France on blue puttee leave should be returned. I am very sorry that Mrs. Newell's wishes cannot be granted, and I am sure you will appreciate the position.

Dear Sir:-

Mrs. Newell, a widow of 67, in very poor health indeed, the mother of Lieut. Corporal William T. Newell, No. 520, who has recently returned from France, is very anxious that her son should either be retained in the work of the Regiment at home or discharged from further service. She is quite alone, her other three sons and her daughters being married, and this son is her only support. In her feeble health, she feels that if he should go to the front again and be killed, it would kill her. She has, as I know, been suffering from nervous debility, as probably Dr. Scully, her medical attendant is prepared to testify. She has requested me to bring her plea before the military authorities.

Mrs. Newell, residing at 14 Nunnery Hill, has a son, 520 Private William T. Newell, with the Regiment in France. She has been ill all winter, and is now suffering from nervous prostration. She has been receiving ~~eighteen~~ sixteen dollars a month of her son's pay, and an allowance of \$8 a month from the Patriotic Association. She declares that under present conditions she finds these sums inadequate, and has asked me to make application on her behalf for a 'Separation Allowance' in addition, which she states, some widows are receiving. She said she would be willing to forego the amount from the Patriotic Fund if desired, if a substantial Separation Allowance could be granted her. Her son was her only support, she says.

I told her I thought any request for a Separation Allowance would have to come from her son, but that I would forward her statement and application to the military authorities. Hence this letter.
