I am directed to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 8th inst., in which you make application for War Service Gratuity.

I am to advise you that the Regulations require a man, who has not proceeded Overseas, to serve twelve months in Newfoundland before he is entitled to War Service Gratuity. As you have not been Overseas and did not serve twelve months in the Regiment - you having enlisted on April 15th 1918 and received your discharge on December 5th/18 - you will not receive any payment on this account.

With regard to your enquiry as to School fees, I may say that this is a matter for the Civil Re-establishment Committee, and I am forwarding your letter to the Vocational Officer requesting him to write you in this connection.




