Dear Sir: -

Referring to your instructions of a previous date I beg to say: (re pension) Since hearing from you I have been to the Militia Dept. and have been boarded and was informed that my pension would be raised to \$10.⁰⁰ ~~27~~ per month and that my 23 months of back money would be paid up at once. This was about three weeks ago, with that I came home but have

rec'd no money and no instructions from them yet.

I went over seas March 20th. 1915 and served with the colours eighteen months, and while ~~was~~ ^{was} orderly, through using eye dress. injuries to my eyes, and after receiving treatment at Craigleith Hospital at Edinburgh was sent to the 4th General Scottish Hospital, Glasgow Major Turges was the eye specialist who treated my eyes for three weeks, the consequences were that when I was practically blind and general debility I was sent home and discharged.

I rec'd \$8.⁰⁰ per month

until Dec. 1917 and have rec'd nothing since. Now Sir, I am in a position where I need this money and need it badly.

Now I am owed 23 months back money at \$10.⁰⁰ per month - which is equal to \$230.⁰⁰ If you can secure this for me, you can pay yourself out of it. Otherwise send me your bill and I will settle it - at once.

Your reference of 10th. September.

This man was discharged from the Service before the institution of the Standing Medical Board.

He was re-employed, and later on his services dispensed with as he was found unsuitable.

I would therefore recommend that his former discharge be confirmed, and that any disabilities through the Militia Service be rated in accordance with his present condition, as far as he is affected by his defective eyesight.

As far as I am aware his previous condition did not show any signs of rheumatism.


