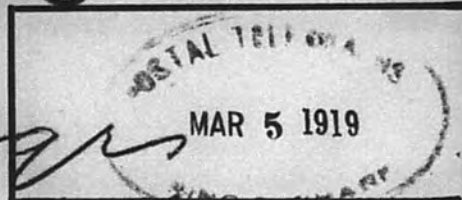

### ALL MESSAGES SENT ARE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:
