rests with the Militia Department.
Now Sir I want to know if
it is possible for P. to Jerry
Benton, to be released or exempted
from service according to
proclamations he might claim
exemption.

As I have to earn
my living at the fishery & help
support one discharged son I
think P. to Jerry Benton should
stay with for a year or two
as I don't think its right for
some homes to be destitute &
others scarcely feel the effect
at all
