Our records show that Pittman who at the time was working in the mill here left in May 1916 to enlist, and according to information received from the Regimental authorities at the time he was then turned down as medically unfit, and we have nothing further from him until we had a letter from him from Pilleys Island claiming that he served with the Regiment "two years and 136 days", and that he was discharged disabled.
