Dear Sir,-

The above named soldier was granted leave to proceed to his home in August last and on Sept. 4th a message was received from him to the effect that he was ill and could not come to St Johns until he had orders from his doctor. Since that time he has not reported back to Barracks.

On Jan. 29th I wrote to him, asking for an explanation for his long absence, and also asking for a doctor's certificate covering the period of his illness. On Feb. 4th he replied stating that he had been attended by you for a "bad back", but that he was fit to return to the Depot in October, which, however, he failed to do.

Will you kindly furnish me with a report on his case and let me know at what date in your opinion he was able to return to duty and state whether he suffers from any disability due to Military Service.

He is about to be discharged now and these particulars are necessary in order to finalize his pay account.
