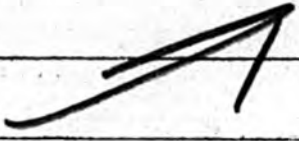

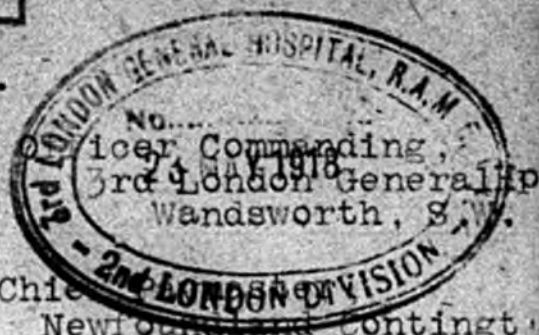

I would probably get as much satisfaction from him as I have got from the others.

My discharge was confirmed on August 30th last.
