Sir,

Mr. Robinson, late of the Government Engineer's Office, enlisted sometime ago with the Regiment. At the present time the Government Engineer is so busy with matters pertaining to the Department of Shipping, as well as with the Tonnage Committee, that it is impossible for him to get through his work, and the inspection of the railway line is very necessary at the present moment. At a meeting of the Executive Government held on Monday evening, it was decided to approach the Military Authorities with the request that they would give Mr. Robinson leave of absence for three or four months for the purposes of railway inspection. It is thought that the circumstances are such as would justify such leave of absence, for as you are aware the condition of the railway certainly needs attention, and the work of inspection is urgent and important. I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of 25th. inst. enclosing my Discharge Certificate from the Royal Newfoundland Regiment.

On the face of the Certificate the following note is written in red ink:-

"Granted leave without pay at his own request  
after attestation to continue in civil  
employment."

As this statement is absolutely incorrect I regret that I cannot accept the Discharge Certificate, which I herewith return.

The facts of the case are as follows:-  
The Executive Government, without my knowledge, applied to the Department of Militia for my services for four months to supervise urgent constructional work on the railway. The first intimation I had of this application was conveyed to me by the District Officer Commanding, who also informed me that the Department of Militia had granted the request of the Executive Government.

As I never directly, or indirectly, requested leave of absence either to continue in Civil Employment or for any other purpose I must respectfully ask that my Discharge Certificate be amended accordingly.
