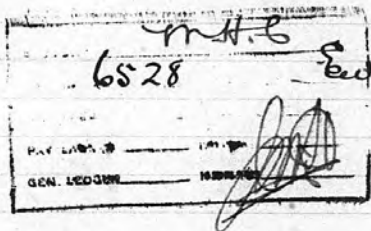

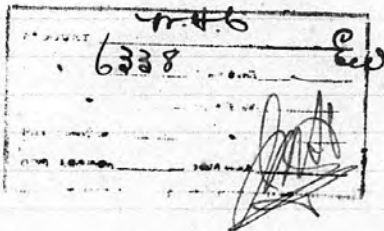

Dear Sir:-

I have been in conversation with the Prime Minister concerning a laboratory assistant for the Public Health Officer. Dr. Wrehm has urged the Prime Minister to have Rowe who is at present at the Grenfell Hall, sent to Halifax, or some other suitable place, for a course as a laboratory assistant in connection with the treatment for venereal diseases. It is understood that Rowe has already applied to the Civil Re-Establishment Committee for a course as above intimated, and that the C.R.C. was unable to bring his case within the scope of their regulations. However, the Prime Minister is aware of the necessity for such an assistant and has authorized payment from this Department on a similar scale to that paid by your Committee. As the matter of payment is therefore settled, I should be glad if you will take up the other arrangements in order that this man may be sent to Halifax for the desired course.
